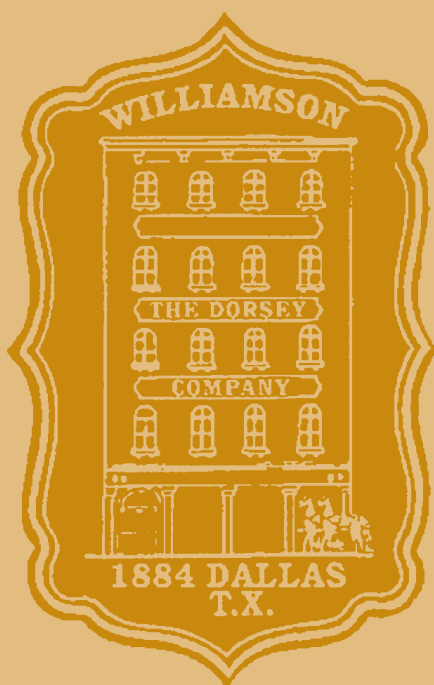

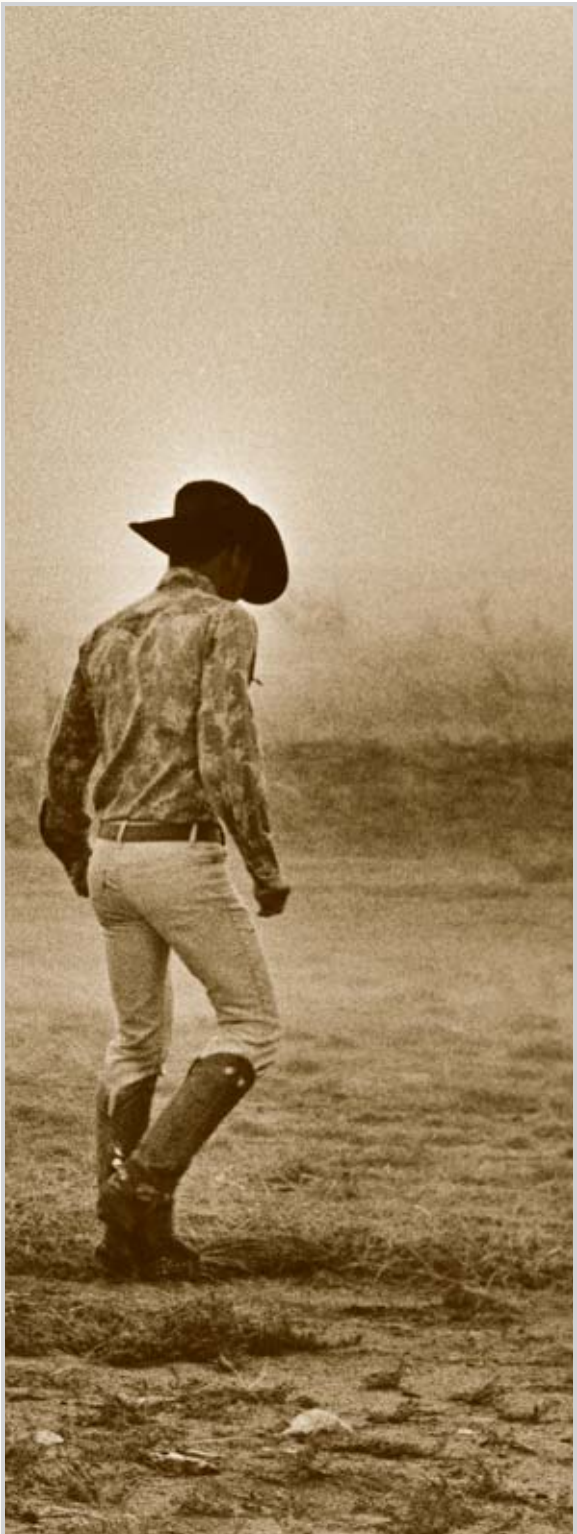


PROLOGUE

When folks think of printing, the name that's branded in most people's minds is that of Williamson. But many don't know about the long road it took to become one of the nation's best printers, nor do they reckon all the capabilities this printer with a heart really has.

So, sit a spell, and learn a lil' bit of history, a lil' bit about our equipment, where to get your vittles, where to rest your head at night, and where to kick up your heels when you come to visit us.







PIONEERS

THE WILLIAMSON LEGACY

A long, long time ago, back in 1884, two brothers – James A. and Henry Dorsey – got it into their minds to partner and open up a printing company and office supply store. A resourceful lot, James worked the crowds as a promoter and entrepreneur handling sales, while Henry, the quieter of the two, manned the print shop on a street called Elm in Dallas, Texas.

The brothers named it the Dorsey Company and it was immediately successful. Between 1884 and 1900, it braved the harsh calamities of two fires. Yet the brothers persevered, and their company came to be one of the largest firms of its kind in the region, stepping up as one of young Dallas' major businesses.

Undaunted and determined, the Dorsey brothers continued on, changing addresses and blazing their trail through the American countryside as one of the nation's premier printing and office supply companies. From selling ledgers to bank vaults, to pioneering the lithography process and engraving techniques, the brothers stood tall above their competitors. They boasted the most improved equipment, labor and time saving methods, as well as the determination they both started with in 1884. The Dorseys, with all of their tenacity, skill, and assets, were the quickest and best at serving their patrons. Time passed, and with it, the Dorsey Company grew in size and influence, despite the death of the two founders, James in 1913 and Henry in 1928. The family business stayed in the hands of Henry Dorsey, Jr. Then came the dark days of the Great Depression, and though the company survived, it seemed to have lost its earlier steam.



That's when Bowen Williamson stepped into the picture. Bowen had been trained in the printing business by his uncle, W.R. Boyd, owner of the Boyd Printing Company of Dallas. In 1940, he started out with the Dorseys as a salesman. Hardworking and tenacious, he quickly rose through the company's ranks to sales manager, then to vice president, and later he became a member of the board. After Henry Dorsey, Jr., passed away in 1963, changes and events led to Bowen's sole proprietorship of the company in 1964. However, this acquisition wasn't quite satisfactory to young Bowen. After a change of hands between a trust company and a third party, Williamson bought the printing division of the Dorsey Company, and in 1970, the Williamson Printing Corporation came to be, and quickly became a name to reckon with.

Since then, the Williamson name has been branded into minds across the country as one of the nation's best printers. Williamson pioneered in many areas, like being the region's first to have a half-size heat-set web press in 1975, adding a full size in 1978, and many more giant feats. Bowen Williamson left a lasting impression and tradition for sons Jerry and Jesse Williamson to carry on after his death in 1983.

The Williamson brothers still do so. They carry on a legacy of exceptional printing and service coupled with compassion, integrity, and honesty in their dealings with customers, employees and suppliers. Reared on an old-fashioned work ethic and raised with the same trailblazing spirit passed on from generation to generation, the Williamson brothers will ride on into the future, embarking on blazing innovations and improved processes just as two other brothers did over a hundred years before.

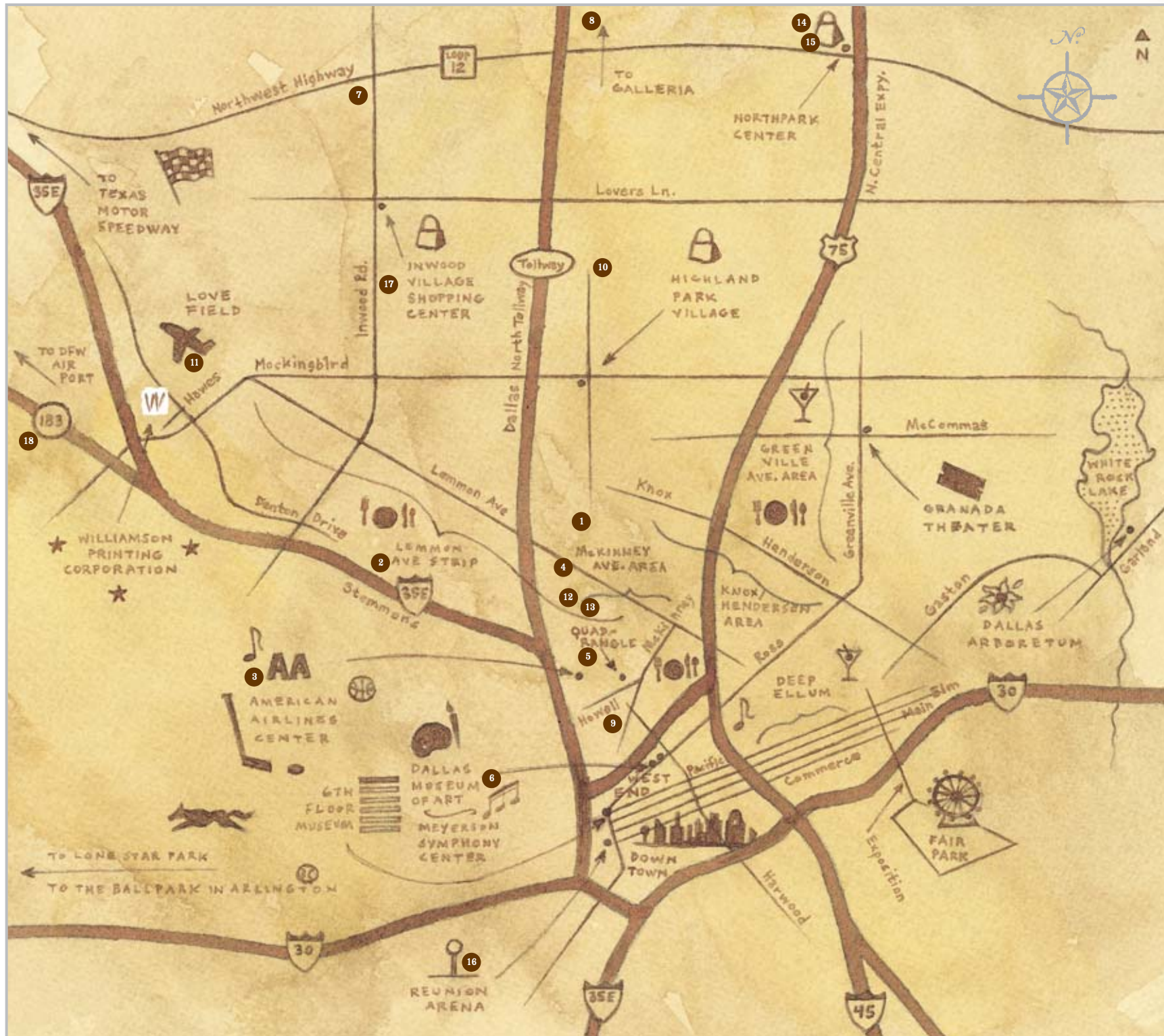

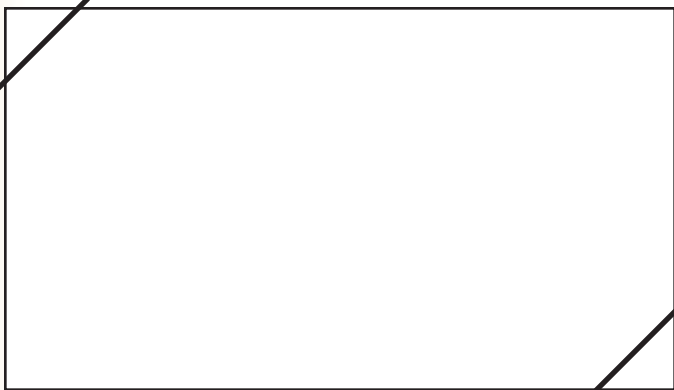
